To help prevent this from happening to you, South Florida Title Insurers has implemented procedures to protect your money from cyber-crime during transactions.

Outgoing Wire:

Before funds are transferred, you'll be asked for written instructions on how you prefer to receive money that may be due to you after closing. If you choose to have funds sent via wire transfer, South Florida Title Insurers will contact you by phone to confirm the wire information you provided prior to sending your funds.

Incoming Wires to South Florida Title Insurers :

For all incoming fund transfers, South Florida Title Insurers will send specific wire instructions to you or your lender via encrypted email/link. *Important* Please note we will never change our company wire instructions prior to closing. Before sending your funds, we encourage you contact us by phone at a known number to confirm instructions.
